Investment Overview

The fund seeks long-term capital appreciation by investing primarily in a diversified portfolio of small-capitalization Canadian equities that have proven management and long-term growth plans. The fund may also invest in foreign securities.

Fund Highlights

- **Small caps provide diversification.** Ideal for investors seeking to add small caps to an investment portfolio can to complement large- and mid-cap holdings and help generate superior risk-adjusted returns over time.

Glossary

For a portfolio, the value represents a weighted average based on the stocks held. **Price to Book:** The price per share of a stock divided by its book value (i.e., net worth) per share. For a portfolio, the value represents a weighted average of the stocks it holds. **Price to Earnings (12-Month Trailing)** is the share price of a stock, divided by its per-share earnings over the past year. For a portfolio, the value represents a weighted average of the stocks it holds.
